Willie down town in morning got at F & S rape seed 26 cts frames 15 meat at Bergins \$1.25 goods at Russells drug got cheese at R B B send \$2.00 to Hornerville & cts stamp cost 30 cts each. Mr Fussy scuffled turnips P.M. Willie finished cultivating corn then chopped some. Willie brought up F & M took them down again evening. P.M. Mrs Jno Armstrong and Isabel, Mesdames S McKee and Jameson and Mitch and Miss Wilson came to see dettor also Arthur & wife all had tea here host the Armstrongs and McKee & Jameson. Mr J.C.
