 land No 7 thus finishing manure for this season
 then Willie finished disked it - I had corn
 PM Willie drove Father & mother up we
 raked alfalfa cut ready twice and hauled it in
 two loads' load. Mary gave mother 50cts

Fine morning clouded over rained in PM
 and evening. We had some corn and got
 1 1/2 loads alfalfa in waded up what was left
 Girls and I went to church PM. Mr. Klein
 Evanson preached from 2 Cor. 4:17. toll 5-
 We got at Armstrong's one sugar loaf buckwheat
 40 strawberries ^{\$5.30} 80. Girls got at Russell's one

Saturday

Fine sunny cool day, breezy. We harrowed
 rolled and drilled up and sowed rape land
 today drills also worked good. Willie
 down at noon got at Armstrong's a lbs rape
 seed and he brought up Father, I drove him
 down at night I got at Russell's one of 5-
 more lbs dry goods Paid Phillips one
 in full \$5.37 got besides 2 lbs hair green 50
 at Dennis one oil can 12
