

- Fri May 6. Fine bright perfect day, put in more peas. fixed Coal bin in cellar. at S.S. Concert at United Church in eve. Mrs Davidson and I for a walk in afternoon.
- Sat May 7. Fine and quite warm. I varnished Coal Oil Stove. Lorraine and I at the grave yard in the evening. a little fire in afternoon.
- Sun May 8. Fine bright day. at morning Church. and at eve. Ch. out for walk.
- Mon May 9. Rained steadily all morning, doing a great deal of good. I put Four coats away. Clear at noon. with fog. at Annies as she in Toronto ^{are}
- Tue May 10. Rained part of morning then cleared with very high wind.
- Wed May 11. Dull and cool. painters started at 8 A.M. Mr Clements and a man. Annie helping with Ladies Aid at Mrs Boyles.
- Thur May 12 Dull and cool with sprinkles every little while but did not prevent men painting. I cut grass.
- Fri May 13 Fair and cool. brightened at noon first sun for several days. men painting. then clouded by night. Shuttles put up wet. Annie here at night.
- Sat May 14. Damp and showery, so men could not work. rained heavily in the afternoon, cleared at four. I went to Speights. Tom and Jennie called for me at 6:45. started to rain again in the evening.
- Sun May 15. Dull with light showers and mist most of day. at Church three times. Eaton Memorial in the evening and to Allan Knight's to call.
- Mon May 16. Dull with light showers. I came home about 10 A.M. men not here as too damp. at M. Watson in eve.
