P.M. bought small <sup>Band</sup> @ 20¢  
Recessors Dale P.M. W. Rain till about  
10 A.M. pretty clear Mild P.M. a pretty  
heavy thunders shower last night  
27 A.M. Henry split wood in bush A.M.  
they went to J. Case over the Sawing Bee  
P.M. W. Cold N.W. wind all day frost  
ing tonight  
28 A.M. Henry finished splitting wood A.M.  
A truck Butter & Eggs to Lewis Henry Chard  
A.P. went to J. Hunter's Dale on 4th Con  
Picking with Thomas P.M. he bought  
a 3 Spring waggon in pretty good condition  
@ \$3.50 W. Cold N.W. wind there is  
lots of snow yet on the 7th Con, all came in  
slugs to the sales. Thomas went with  
Spring waggon Return was here until P.M.

29 A.M. & Henry cut <sup>April</sup> summer wood in old  
bush. there were 17 Wild Geese down  
on our Meadow this P.M. A & I went  
for Bird's David & Thomas David has  
a Gasol Rifle he fired 3 shots among  
them but did not kill any W. front  
last night Cold N.W. wind Clear  
thruing some through the day  
30 Boy split a lot of posts in the R. Sawing  
A.M. J & A went to Markham P.M. Henry  
drew 2 loads Pine roots from 5<sup>th</sup> Con near  
Flavin's P.M. W. Clear Cold N.W. wind  
Amelia, Ernest & Carl were here to dinner  
Dandy 31 at home Ada Han was here to dinner  
I & Mary went to Flavin's P.M. street to supper  
W. Clear Cold N.W. wind thunders some  
April 1 A & Henry piled wood in old bush  
they also tapped 9 trees Sap runs well  
I tapped in dooryard & Mary boiled  
2 qts Molasses by adding some sugar  
I went to Hermon's P.M. to ask him  
to bring some mails from Toronto he is going  
on Wednesday Por C. called while P.M.  
W. very fine & Clear. Cold wind from north  
2 Boy bowed down dead on Fall Wheat  
this morning then they brought big load  
Pine roots from Flavin's & brought home the  
Sap from bush there was a big man I beat  
in the shop & Henry finished on the stove  
she made 2 qts. Course today
