another stretch of turnips getting them half done
took in 4 loads turnip box to-day. We also plowed
~~some more~~ ^{rest of} potato land No 4 & picked 43 peckful potatoes
then plowed sod No 5. A.M. I plowed out some
more rows potatoes in N.D. in morning just picked them
Mary walked down P.M. home and back again.
We gave Barbours 2 sts to get letters out of post office.

Wednesday

Mostly cloudy chilly. We worked at turnips got in
3 turnip box loads I finished plowing rest D.S.P. in No 5
and picked stones off another drain width. P.M. I drove
down to Kenneth Mills funeral the high school pupils
and Cadets there I got at Merris hog rings 10 sts Fools
bread 12 sts meat Montreux 50 sts. Fools shak
got in to ours and Willie & Emory had a time separating them
The girls walked up to Skocho & Gregious Belwood
road P.M. got ride up 20 for with C Nelson.

moderately cold. Willie drove me down en route
to Guelph he got 'Wood' 1 st. I went to Guelph stock
sales Ben Crowley & left Robson antiques. I bought
kifer Barry gave cheque for \$90.00
in I.B. stamp 2 sts fare to Guelph 70 sts paid
Nursery subscription till 1916 \$2.00 paid for
watch cleaning \$1.50 dinner 30 in fare 10 sts
Willie plowed No 5. I came up with Mary who
had been down to Arthur with swollen cheek and
was waiting at Uncle Jim's for me.
Father came up and Bella cut his hair.
