out to Fisher's corner and back to  
2nd concourse and home. Longest-  
walk I ever took. Not so dusty to-  
day. Mrs. Ryan going to Ceven Sound  
with Bert Lemke who is to have her  
tonsils removed. Mrs. Green to do the  
work while she is away. Wrote to Frank.  
Cleared off table. Played double Solitaire  
with Dorothy. Was awakened before 6 a.m.  
by black birds - I said "damn" and  
Charles grunted out: "I wish I had  
a gun." Migrating - hundreds on  
more settled in our beets - on very  
high tings & such a clatter!
