

Mr James Cannon Island

I left of writing any thing down since
the latter end of July 1877 when fine
fall and a very fine winter. But the
ice was not very good as it was open
from here up to the lower end of
Island and down from here to Lane
we had to go down by the Mt. K.
Island and keep down east to the foot of
Rop's Island south side till we were
the road that crosses to Mr. Phe's
and a great deal of travel on that road
this winter so I have only very few things
to write down as I kept no account of
or of any thing that happened. I did a few
things here and there Feb 4th 1878.

I went to Hopkins on the 5th at Hopkins
with John Baker for Hay. I went to Williams
Pully tongue Potatoes from Hopkins 9th at home 10 Sunday
11th 12th 13th Charlie Hopkins here went up with
Charlie I went to Sydney Bought 2 beavers a corn
14th Jim Charlie and Jim Sumner came for the
steers took the mare yoked the steers and
left them till he would take them home on
the sleigh 15th loaded with a lot of
for the way Bought of J. Grant
16th Rice Hansons starch Broom
17th matches Flour took dinner at Hamilton
18th got the 2 collars sent them
