 Wed 4 it Rained Nearly all Day I cleaned up Sun More
 Thu 5 I finished Plowing down on Owens Place to day a Very Heavy Frost Last Night
 Fri 6 I was Plowing all Day at Home a Nice warm
 Sat 7 I finished Plowing to day at Noon I was Roling 2
 Sun 8 another Nice warm Day The ground is green
 Mon 9 I Had Mr Harsh Plowing at Springs work for me
 Tue 10 I Put in a new floor in the Kitchen Pat Sullivan did
 Wed 11 I finished Sowing Grain Heare to day a Very warm
 Thu 12 another Heavy Rain at Night I Painted the Kitchen
 Fri 13 A Very Heavy Rain all the fore noon
 Sat 14 Mr Thomas Burns Died in Montreal at 6 PM
 Sun 15 I Pulverized Mr Keatings Potatoes ground in the fore noon
 I Sowed 2 Bushels of oats an Millet of Peas
 I finished Sowing grain down on Owens Place I Sowed 3 Bushels
 a Very Nice warm Day
