Fannie prepared stew kitchen Paul took our turkey away again. Mary Reisinger called to see if their turkey was here. I started my woollen quilt Paul swept the school house it was so cold I baked in good bread 19 wind south west very high & not so cold. Frank Miller died yesterday. I set things at night.

Thurs 20 drizzly part of the day Paul went to Chippewa. Paul brought home a card telling us about Frank Miller's death. He was buried this afternoon next at the house at 3 o'clock. Then at all saints church on the side Mrs Reisinger came past as Paul was going away & stayed until he came back Fannie's up to tea Mary I baked bread & plum tart. Friday 21. Good Friday day some shiny weather rained part of the time & snowed part of the time great big flakes the largest I ever saw when the water was laying all over the ground from the heavy rain on the night. The cows would not stay long enough to drink watered them by the pail at night. We had a mess of fish

Sat 22. Sun out nice again. Polly brought Marjorie home in the afternoon I was mending Paul's pants all forenoon after nailed down some oil cloth to patch up holes cleaned the floor. I blacked the stove. Marjorie had a bad face all swelled from her eye tooth. Fannie went to Chippewa after Hattie she came home from Berlin just gone two weeks. Paul went after the turkey. Mary don't seem to get much better.

Sun 23. Beautiful day. The girls were taken on the church. The minister in dinner with other house. Let here he supper & Fannie will in Peter's Keller started his meeting. Mon 24. Fannie went last night to James Bell in set up with Mrs Smith the & Hattie Linger sat up last night. Marjorie drove over & the & Fannie went to Chippewa to see Papa she was at Fannie's. came back by Drummond got 50 lbs of corn meal 21.30 per cent.

Tue 25. beautiful day quite hot. Paul in forenoon he will pulling down fence. I started to fix the pig pen in cel. she pigs out. I fell to mean just like the trap come on to quick my head it sloped up & I a ch all over. James & Fredie ploughing along the road yesterday he & roped. Hattie & her mother went to town they changed Paul's shoes & still business
