Dead English cherry not very well
making cedar Requests N Wind
15th Fine N Wind Fine Gordon and
Leander Working at the swamp
fence and Randolph went
to Dundee I wrote a letter
to George Charrone stall No
3 Fishmarket Bouscours Market
3 of one and I putting a fence
around the apple tree up at the
coal-pit Hill as the cows destroy
them Making Ribs of Oak for the
boat Gordon and Leander and
Stanley Harrowed the Potatoes
Yesterday seen 2 Flies Randolph
Bought Basseline Shaving Soap
and collars 1 Plug of Tobacco 30 hair
cut 20 cents 16th Fine North and West
Wind William Morris and Peter Grant
here Argue Talking to the Boys
about Boards taken from his
Island none of his Boards
here clearing Brush at the
fence Drew stones for the Bottom
of the fence Mr Gene came had
the Dog Sport Gordon went for his saw
at the Making of the Foot
