

January Monday 4 1926

Very mild damp day which
took practically all the snow
away. Drove sleigh for last time
for a while. Didn't get home
until late after a very busy
morning.

Tuesday 5

Damp mild day. Alex drove
big truck and helped me saddle
from it. Home about one o'clock
after having driven big truck with
Kupke change for first time when
I delivered in the Upper Town and
plato myself. Cleaned harness at
night.

Wednesday 6

Saddled milk with Sis. Got first
democrat for the first time. Damp
raw windy morning with nasty snow
storm. Team started for home while
I was in Sis. In harness but Lloyd
Hopper stopped them at corner of
Warwick. Cleaned brass at night.

January Thursday 7 1926

Dandy cold bright day. Up early and
away on my route at 7.45 but didn't
get home until 12.45. Heavy cold
started in on my chest and throat
getting worse near night. Ernie Buck
had a cold upon his chest so he
rubbed it with camphorated oil and
went to bed early.

Friday 8

Cold frosty morning turning still colder
with easterly winds later in the day.
Felt pretty tough all day with
bad cold on my chest and sore throat.
Got some medicine from Dr. Jeffrey.
Alex helped me with milk route and
my bottles. All alone at night as Billy's
fell went to a party. Started to snow
about eleven o'clock.

Saturday 9

Snowed very hard until after three
so that by morning there was about
six or eight inches on the level. Drove
new milk sleigh for first time and Bob
came down and drove the team for me.
Felt pretty tough in afternoon so came home
and went to bed. Dr. Cary gave 32 B. d. m. m.
Surnace the tuberculin test.
