- 2 Fine bright day. To 2 loaves 12. 1 gall coal oil 20 matches 5. W. H and F. M. out in Vestry will meet in Vestry for the winter, on Wednesday for it will be warm for Prayer Meeting, My off for both 1.50 for each, I paid the M. B. dollar 1.00

- 4 Fine soft day
- 5 1 big loaf 12
- 6 2 lbs lard 40. Milk 42 - This was a glorious day, not even freezing. Murdy is not home yet he went away on Wednesday
- 7 Fine day, some rain, not many in church off 25
- 8 When I got up at 7.30 A.M. the ground was covered with snow, and it looks like winter, sent letter to Marion To rolled oats 25 flaked corn 10. 2 loaves 12
- 9 Fine bright day Ann 1/2 day 35. 3. P. M looks like snow - 5
- 10 Murdy went away in a cutter
- 11 Fine day, 3 loaves 18 1/2 lb B. tea 20
- 12 Turning off - Murdy came home, afraid that the sleighing would go off
- 13 Jimmie got home a bag of wood and some oat shavings To Milk 42. (Murdy paid 2 loaves 12, 1 gall coal oil) 20
- 14 Snow mostly all gone. Our lawn, and Cemetery look green (Church off 25 Jimmie)
- 15 Fine sunrise No snow, wheeling, Council met
