Sat Jan 28 clear and cold. the moniter 2 deg
below zero this morning. I was thrashing
out peas part of the day. Walter attending
the stock, John at home with a bressed
foot

Sun Jan 29 cloudy and moderate

Mon Jan 30 cloudy and moderate. Walter and
I took some wheat to Shamesville and
exchanged for flour

Billton, y. Mary fill out some pedigrees
this fore noon, after noon I and Walter
went to Florence

Sun came out this Evening long enough
for the bear to see his shadow. we were
sawing stove wood

Fri Feb 3 cloudy most of the day and soft.
we were cutting stove wood most of the
day John's foot is getting better he is
able to be around again

Sat Feb 4 cloudy and soft. Some rain this fore
noon. we were shelling corn for chop.

Sun Feb 5 cloudy and cool. Some snow last night.

this fore noon after noon attended the
Quarterly Board at Florence
