Rectal Hints.

The ideal treatment of hemorrhoids is extirpation with clamp and cautery. Give the patient a cathartic two days before operation and keep him on a light diet. The night before and the morning of the operation, give 2 per cent. hydrogen peroxide enemas. Use a general anesthetic if possible. The clamp and cautery can be employed with local anesthesia, but this is not advisable. Insert the rectal tube. The second night after operation inject olive oil through the rectal tube and give the patient a dose of castor oil. The following morning the tube comes away. Follow the bowel movement with 2 per cent. hydrogen peroxide irrigation.—Wagner; *Int. Journ. of Surg.*
