I went down in sledge in A.M. got pails mended at Kerrs 10cts paid to father for Johnstone for thrashing \$21.00 brought load manure from Steals and bag shorts and 2 sacks salt on sledge from Austin took load (box) straw to Graham. In P.M. we spread with spreader 8 loads on No 1 also Steale load. Willie went down town straight got at Phillips Spruce 50c 25cts Doobie 10cts at Mennis lamp glass 10 hookstaple 5 paid 2 1/2 coal sledge and tile \$4.67 (299 quads tile) paid on Armstrong sledge \$35.00
