Put out 100 Cabbage Plants
Boat went Down Narcisse had Leander
175 Fisched the Sail with mast Fishing
to night 4th of June old George the Shucks
B Day it used to be kept for a long time
I rained sawing wood Leander crossed to
Summerstown Bought of Mr. Ward sack
of Salt 80 paid Paint oil got a
Pail of Dust Sea from Mrs. Hamlin
seen a Man passing here about
7 o'clock Kept Down went the
way of Rosses Island and he
seemed strange the way he was going
around I fished the 2 Logs on the Bank

Pentecost Whit Sunday Randolph and
Dan Spink here Raining Mr. Genie
here from Cornwall 6th On this Day of

1891 Cleaning the sprouts of the Potatoes
in the cellar sawing stove wood & Win
7th Fine Day & Wind Peeling stove wood
The 2 girls to Lewis's with Potatoes
for him to plant got cabbage plants
The Boat Sheep going to stop at Lewis's
Frank Laplants Daughter Married
yesterday 8th Fine & Wind commenced
working at the south window with 2
glass in it commenced to rain lots of
shooting at the Kit Kit Fishermen to
Pancaster Frank Laplante at Hamilton's
Wharf Randolph came from Malone
got the loan of John Tyro's Boat
9th Ainity McAvy's B Day 1893
Leander and Randolph to Dundee
with J. Tyro's Boat Rained some
Stanley and I went around the island
10th Randolph put 2 Boards in the floor
up stairs cutting weeds in the Potatoes
Last of the sheep a Lamb
Narcisse took his boat from Pancaster
