5<sup>th</sup> Month May 10 Day 10 1902

a very hot day Had Road  
I moved to W. McBlair up to his factory at  
Harrisburg  
I got 30 Bushels of oat from J. Harrisburg  
a Nice But Cold Day I was working at Harrisburg

another Very Nice But Cold Day  
The Roads are Nice and dry

I was working at Harrisburg  
I was cutting up Hay at Harrisburg  
I was drawing Stone to the Mill at Lansdowne
