Misty Drizzling Seander to Dougalls Stanley went
for the Mare Making Hay Blinds on the Boathouse
Mr Genie there Blackbirds at the Beechnuts a
Seander came to night 1 lb Tea 10th 76. A 13 Day
St Dennis Day a very Fine Day Drew some
of the Timber over to the House on the Pitt Point
Gordon fixing off the Timber Randolph here
Working at the Hay-Blinds with Stanley
and Seander Tom and I Fishing got a Lot
Sent Fixing at Ace handles Gordon and
Seander to Dundee Salted the cows Seander and
Gordon went to Dundee Bought Hayseed
Boots coats drawers undershirts
Soap Dan Spink here with Sturgeon to
sell to Jo Lemay 11th Fine Fernandez to Lemay
to sell his Fish put up the Thrashing Mill
Thrashed 28 Bushels of Oats to Day Lewis
here took Home the 2 Inch Auger
have him some pipes Ed Kenshaw here
Fixing my Irons crockery Pipes and Corks
12th Thrashing 45 Bushels to Day that's
13 Bushels of Oats out of the first Stack
Moved the Mill into the Barn Made
Blinds last night and to Day Randolph at Blinds
Brought me the Witness came from Dan
Killed 2 Roosters Sucas to 2 Bushels of Oats 25
Began Boiling Potatoes for the Hogs

Fine Randolph here took away the Blinds and
Him and Seander took up the scow & Wind
took up 9 Rows of Potatoes about 20 Bushels
to Day that's 260 Bushels in the cellar now
Gordon at the frame Seander at Jo Dougalls
14th Fine few Drops of Rain West Wind Harrowing
and Ploughing the East Peice of Potatoes took
up to Day about 6 Bushels Gordon to Summerston
a Big Fire over the way of Mr Dougalls
Marsh like Stacks Blurning Making
Grape Jelly Salted the Cattle 15th Fine W Wind
John Ho and Donald Spink here have
John Ho a pair of Mts 16th My Paper up
Fine East Wind Randolph here heard the
Canal was Broke no Boats a going saying
the Foundation of the House taking over
the Lumber from here Blackbirds plenty
Sparrows plenty on the stacks Eddy here
got Nails at Haggarty's 3 cents all 17th
Fine W Wind Working at the Building
Fernandez to Lancaster Windy very noisy
putting a handle in the axe 18th St Sills Day
Rained hard Last night Sucas for Potatoes 25 cents
Fernandez came took Linabe from Lancaster
Boots Stanley sent for under clothes working at
the frame Canal fixed Boats coming up
