Sat Jan 12th Some Snow and blustering about six inches of snow on the ground. doing very little these days.

Sun Jan 13th cloudy and soft.

Mon Jan 14th cloudy Snow or rain most of the day doing very little to day

Tue Jan 15th foggy. I went down to the farm and cleaned out oats in the fore noon

Wed Jan 16th cloudy high wind and cold. not doing any thing to day James Cragg was buried this after noon.

Thu Jan 17th cloudy and cool some snow not doing much

Fri Jan 18th cloudy and cold. doing as yesterday

Sat Jan 19th clear and cold. not doing any thing

Sun Jan 20th cloudy soft wind all day roads getting muddy. this was an average day Mr. Homes preached three times in our Church

Mon Jan 21st cloudy and soft. not doing any thing

Tue Jan 22nd clear and pleasant. Fred was here I was visiting with him part of the day

Wed Jan 23rd cloudy soft snow this evening. Dick was here we were seeing our acct for his last years work. Mary Paul was here

Thu Jan 24th cloudy and cool. not doing much we got a telegram last night from Buffalo last night that Victoria is sick

Fri Jan 25th cloudy and cold was splitting wood

Sat Jan 26th cloudy and snow in the evening. doing very little to day
