

- May 1st rained Let a good deal of water of the fields on
 side a good amount to grow more with some loss
 2nd a good amount to Bradsville on the express
 3rd Gandy plowed & sowed the southern side they are
 not much much they sowed
 4th rained most of the day no work done
 5th rained some hours
 6th Do Do Do the ground is very wet
 7th drew some rails from the north road or cross
 road to the old log fence at the old house
 8th there was rain this morning
 9th put up some of the fence at the old house
 the Rev Mr Cochran preached this forenoon
 that Sigler & Ad came home ^{over} this morning
 Express from Perry Sound
 10th finished the putting up of the fence at the old
 house we cannot plow yet the ground is too wet
 11th Gandy chaped wood at the house & cables
 some boots & shoes
 12th Gandy plowed & helped Charles Armstrong
 fix the fence at the concession line in the rear
 the woods look good
 13th sowed 4 bushel of oats in the middle field
 the ground is rather wet yet the wood looks
 14th Gandy plowed he got the south half of the
 middle field plowed to day
 15th sowed 6 bushel of oats in the middle field
 the Rev Mr Cochran preached in the forenoon
 16th plowed the headridge & sowed 1 bushel of oats
 & that finished the south half of the middle
 field we then sowed 5 bushel of wheat in
 the north half of the middle field west side we
 got a letter by to days mail that Mrs Frank Hall
 is dead
 17th Ellen & me went to Bradsville on the morn
 to Mrs Hall's funeral there was a very large funeral
 she was buried by the side of her Brother Robert
 in the new cemetery the Rev Mr Morgan of Oregon. Mulberry
 & the Spiera officiated we got home on the morn

16th sowed
 1 bushel of wheat
 5 bushels of oats
