

Mr James Cameron (Jan) March 16th 1845
Very unwell all of us laid up with bad cold
Gordon came from Williams town had with cold
had 2 papers of Tea 1 lb of Cracken 3 Loaves of Bread
Stuff that Donald McDonald gathered & some
a thing I never knew anything at all about
took it from Hamilton where it was left with a
lot of other stuff they told Gordon for me to go
after tomorrow Gordon took coffee and loaf from
Williams town 1st St. Nicholas Day
I rode to Summit town brought 1 Sheep Belt 1 calf skin
allowed me a Dollar Bought 1/2 lb Soda 1 Phil
Lead for the Cornmeal and 2 lb of Barley got Saturday
leaves a Que. Bag of 4 Cents 1/2 lb of Pickles 1/2 lb of Stormy
and Wild I to Hamilton and Wap. to Cornville
the things that Donald McDonald gathered for
me took from Hamilton 4 1/2 Bushels of Wheat
300 lbs of Flour about 10 lb of Pork 10 lb of Beef 2 1/2 Mutton
1 1/2 lb of Cash Gordon and I came home quite a
surprise not knowing any thing at all about
it nor would I want them to do that for
me Old Mr. John the Priest departed 18th of
Baker and Peter for Gary took a load Gordon
cropped with the wood I got the stuff in Cleared the
store and (Pipes) Whetting Sugar 25 1/2 1/2
Began to draw wood took my jumper to Hendon
got horse sleigh 3 Loads got 1/2 Bottle of H. Wines
of from George for the wife and children sent
him a Piece of sugar Bought a little sleigh
got a new Whisky Cash from Burn an
awful Blast of snow from the West
then into Hamilton took the Fair
down 20th First Day of Spring this Evening
Drove a Fine Day Skinned the Fair
took up a load and I went to Hamilton with
a Bottle of Milk they have a Bell to draw
drawn from Flecker went with
a fine afternoon Drove some upon the
fishes at Christer

Finished drawing to George got a Bag of Potatoes
from Allen Cameron in the Commission
22nd went to the store with the Hides 37 1/2
to Mr. Ward Bought 1/2 lb of Soda 1/2 lb of Soda
2 lb of nails 4 Bunches of Matches went over with
Millsquis Sleigh got yellow and Candles
I turned very strong wind came to Hamilton
Gordon fixing the Lickhouse business
Gordon came from Hamilton with
I could hardly see the way to come
home with the fast wind storm
Heard one of the neighbors was going to being
in the back hills for sheathing a new
very stormy day snowing & drifting
George Bassell and Billie here for the cattle
to make tonight go to Cornville
today and another
scotch moon to day 3 times crazy 25th
Sunday a fine day 21st Gordon went
for As. Bakers Sleigh and Karpner
went straight four the ice to
Genies Port Lewis John Miller August
Departed Stopt at the Lake view
Hotel (Bought 10 Cents worth of H. Wines
2 Annecet) Lalaw 25th at Kene
went down to St. Jernan went to see old
Mr. Rankin the Blacksmith and
he is Roorly 29th in McDougall
ere for the sugar Bush, Rita Ball
here with the adge we came home
from (Dox) Lewis hurried 7 1/2 miles
