Very stormy last night and all day snowing blowing not very frosty. I was down at the Armstrongs all day auditing got dinner at home Bob Glen got 9 bushels mangels today.

Cloudy and sunny colder today. We hauled back 3 loads manure from cattle stable in A.M. and went up to Stacey's sale with Jennie in cutter in P.M. Mary went down to prayer meeting Willie drove down for her at night. I paid Bob Indale \$2.00 cow a/c got very stormy at night

Thursday

Mild day, lot more snow fell last night good sleighing now. cloudy, snowing a little. We hauled back 2 loads manure in A.M. went to D. Wrighton's sale in P.M.

Friday

Ran east wind rime on trees cloudy not very frosty. I took 1033 lbs oats to Wilson and brought up load manure from Smalls spread it No 5 took straw to Smalls in P.M. I took 6 bushels or so turnips down to Beattie's and brought up chops 51 cts. Willie drove Gies down town with Jennie in cutter they got at Russells towing etc 35 cts find a/c in full 3 lbs at Weeks found 25 cts. Mrs Knox up in A.M. got 7 lbs butter \$1.50
