The 2nd Month of February 28. Days. (1899)

- Feb 1 The Month Begins fine. an bright but very cold 10 Below zero. I was helping W. Bowen to draw out oak to Eastern
- Feb 2 + Candlemas Day a nice bright. W. W. Day a big snow storm
- Feb 3 I was helping W. N. Bowen to draw out grain all day a little sleighing a very nice warm day
- Feb 4 I was helping W. N. Bowen to a day clean up grain sand
- Feb 5 another nice warm day very poor sleighing a nice warm day
- Feb 6 I was banking out firewood over in the woods to a day No sleighing but fine wheeling a another warm day
- Feb 7 I went to Brockville to attend the County O. T.
- Feb 8 another very cold and blustery day 16 Below zero another terrible cold and blustery day
- Feb 9 I went up with J. Estacey to saw at J. W. Daves
- Feb 10 I was sawing at J. W. Daves another very cold day 20 Below zero
- Feb 11 I was sawing at Jas. McDonalds all day. Very to me
- Feb 12 a very nice day but cold day 15 Below zero
- Feb 13 I was banking out wood to a day, one on parties
