Hyperchlorhydria.

Where patient constipated at beginning of treatment, give suspension of magnesia and bismuth just after and again one and a half hours after meals; each dose to represent 6 grains (0.4 Gm.) of magnesium hydroxide and 22 grains (1.5 Gm.) of bismuth subnitrate. Continue for three to five days, and, if evacuations still too frequent, use instead a powder containing equal volumes of magnesium oxide and magnesium carbonate, with a little powdered charcoal and sometimes bismuth.
