- 3 Sacrament My off 2nd none from here in church but Far and Jean came in afternoon
- 4 I am not going to the kitchen To molasses
we expect some fold from 8-10
Mr & Mrs Brown Mr & Mrs Gordon, Birdie & Laurence Dingwall Mrs F Robinson, Bro Willie and wife, Lullie Wilson and wife John J McDonald and wife, James and Maggie Manning, Tupper and May Miss Mrs J Cottanall Mr & Mrs Samuels George Watson MacLennan and Gums were asked but could not come
- 5 I sat up until 12:30 Monday night and did not get up again until Saturday
I will try and write from memory
- 6 On the Far and Jean went home. I did not get up, had my meals in bed, Jimmie went to Montreal with Marion on the 5th and saw her on the train at Windsor Station. I had to or three notes from her while on train. She had to throw away her chicken and sandwich, and take her meals at the diner. I had a telegraphon yesterday the 12th saying they were married Monday the 11th and left for Seattle. On the 9th Far came from Cornwall with a man from Kentucky to get Miss Dolly - mare - he bought her in the summer for 150 with her colt and sold her alone for 300, he was offered 100 for the colt, I do not know

- 12 whether he sold it or not. I got up on the 9th got that day 2 1/2 lbs steak charged at Sandys 4 hrs 24
on the 10th sent 25^{cts} to church as my off 25
- 13 Birdie went home today was with me a week Murdy left on 11th for Kimprow to be gone a week I am trying to make meals for myself and Jimmie
% 6 bars of soap 25 = 1 gull coal oil 20 45
Mrs PL Thomas paid \$2⁰⁰ last week and John Lavinette paid 2.50 on the 11th for rent - We had one week of very fine weather
- 14 % butter 43 3 loaves 18 verany meat 10 71
Mrs James Dingwall called
- 15 W. T. Mrs D Thankoffung today at the Hall, I sent my off 1⁰⁰ and 25^{cts} for expenses
- 16 Fine bright day Ann Hall 1/2 day 30^{cts} can salmon 50
sent letter to Birdie & Far 40, Birdie did not go
- 17 Bright in afternoon rain in morning & M Dye day 63^{cts} % 4 loaves 24 can salmon 20 Dress
- 18 Murdy got home about 10 P.M. last night Far & wife came today. Birdie & Sophie was called upon by M Lellan for Pilgrims taxes for last year 5.57. paid him % bread 24 fly powder 10 Got factory cheque 201 Paid flour got 17 Sept gull coal 20 got at same time & % lb tea 25^{cts} & M D. all day digging potatoes (May paid Jimmie Mrs Elliotts lard 25) 25
- 19 % pan bread 24 Murdy went west yesterday came home this morning Mary Mc Lennan in this evening 24
- 20 Bright in morning dull now 9:30 P.M., Jimmie had with neuralgia, had a letter from Marion
- 21 Ugly day, rain all day Jimmie had
- 22 Dull and raw. I was not well last night - Jimmie retched a little last night. he milked in the morning, M Donald took the milk to the factory got us 1 gull coal oil 20 24
