TUESDAY, 15

(320-46)

Hunted this morning in north tamarac thicket
Jawey shot 1st doe. put in dogs again
I shot a big doe I jumped, & other was missed by
Murray & shots, and another dogs put out, Murray
fired 6 shots at & missed. altogether 48 shots fired
that morning.

In afternoon went after deer with wagon. Did not parkidge
we are just getting posted as to runways. all season has been
bad for hunting, as the leaves are dry all the time.
A 30.30 would be the best rifle for here.

WEDNESDAY, 16

(321-45)

Left base camp at 7 a.m. got into Lunderville at
1.30 p.m. 14 miles. with 6 deer, leaving 3 hanging
up, & 3 eaten or being eaten.
