We sowed 72 oats across from S D up, seeded down and fertilized as follows As first from fence up by then Gens Pho, by then As again. We sowed truck across where light land was highest. Willie worked after supper got nearly half way up. Mr Laughlin of Arthur in P.M. got 4 2/3 bushels goose wheat at \$2.25 per bushel \$10.50 Mr Fawcett cultivated P.M. while I cleaned seed oats for him and Willie got wheat for Laughlin. Mary down town P.M. ordered trusty chow & elike from Summers got it and cream can sent up to field. Mary got chank at Shortreeds 50 cts paid for meat got April 28th 60 Tom M. Intyre up P.M. he is back again from Winnipeg.

 Willie paid Loghrie for coal got on 2nd \$1.30 got at Dulake buggy spring etc.
