- 22nd Dan came back after being sick for 2 weeks
- 23rd Went to B. Cunningham for a load of oats. Helped R. Atkin to fill his silo.
- 24th J. Atkin & R. Robertson to fill silos
- 26th Went to Paris Fair, and Edith, Leone & I went to Guelph to visit Clarence & Marie staying until Sat. Evening. ^{Black Cow had a little black calf}
- 28th Went to Anniversary Services at the Glen in the morning
- 29th Started to plow for turnips in 14 acre field.
- Oct 1st Helped Mr. Johnson to put up his silo in afternoon.
- 2nd Started to cut corn in the afternoon.
- 3rd Helped Rycrofts to fill their silo.
- 3 & 4th Helped Hartleys & Johnsons to fill their silos
- 5th Communion Service at our Church St. George and Raby Sunday at our Sunday School. Miss Beith Robson of the Glen gave a very fine talk on her work in India, showing the children how the people there, dressed and ate and sleep, and also gave a good description of the country. Mr & Mrs. Shurtliff sang a fine Duett. Rev Mr. McCremon also assisted. There were about 70 people present and over \$4.00 collection
- 6th Helped Frank Reid to fill his silo.
- 7th Finished cutting the corn taking about 4 1/2 bolls of turnips
