less \$8 for chickens \$38

I went to mill this
morning and to exp.
office for chickens, got
14 chickens from J.W. Phillips
Express. Charge \$1⁰⁰
came home and chored
the rest of the day
put ear tags in sheep.

town, I paid taxes \$36⁹⁹
went for Oleate, drugs .05

in afternoon, he is working for
\$1.25 per day & boards himself

the Imported cattle, we have
divided and I have the big
bull except for about 2 1/2
months in summer, and
Mr W. C. takes the heifer Marie
& Proost 15 & 16th of Powrie
