- 22 Ann Hall 1/2 day 30 In afternoon went to John Lis to quilt missionary quilts
- " 7/8 lb oranges 20 molasses 20 1/2 lb tea 20 60
1 lb currants 10
- 23 3 lbs steak at Sunday charged 2 loaves 10 10
- 24 7/8 biscuits 10 fancy biscuits 20, Gave 50 to a man from the Hotel Du Cornwall. Mrs Farguhar MacLennan with two children and Mary called. The entrance is over Jean and Beatrice called for Helen
- 25 Fine day Jimmie went to Finch to a meeting for Borden. 7/8 bread 15 15
- 26 Fine day looks like rain. had no off
- 27 Muddy left for North Lancaster 7/8 2 loaves 10 10
- 28 Fine cool day. did some ironing. took the handle of iron
- 29 Borrowed handle from Mrs Campbell Mrs St Thomas paid \$2.00 Turn to April 1910

July 1910

- 1 Friday Farguhar and Florie Conlin of Toronto came about 9 a.m. she went to Martintown after dinner. She was with me all day 7/8 biscuit 15 Meat biscuit 20. 2 loaves 15 40
- 2 7/8 lb butter 25. 3 loaves 15 40
- 3 I did not go to church sent my off 25 25
- 4 Mr Crimmon paid me \$20.00. 4-65 which settles his rent up to May 1910 -
- 5 Lapair paid Jimmie \$4.00 for two months rent May - June. Paid Jimmie \$2.00 which settles Tom Heenans rent. 7/8 bread 15. Butter 15 30
- 6 Fine very hot - Ann Hall 1/2 day 30 30
Jimmie and Muddy went to The P School picnic. to Hammonds Island
A hen stole a nest and brought out 6 black chick yesterday.
Annie MacLennan Lancaster arrived on the mail to visit me 7/8 butter 95 bread 15
- 7 7/8 salmon 20 We thought to go to W. & M. S. but it poured rain all afternoon Jimmie drove Mrs Annie to Mrs A. C. McEller in evening. I missed a big pullet
- 8 There were
- 9 There were four big chickens but this morning two turned up about 10 a.m. 7/8 3 loaves 15
Muddy went to Cornwall
- 10 This morning a hen that had young chickings was taken and worned and carried off. nothing left but feathers John Birkie and John F. were down. They did not go to church not in time. I went Put in all my poultry
- 11. Hens and chickens killed in the village last night
