Wednesday Sept 18 1872

Cold raw and wet, the Boys still hanging have so all time in and much I thought the weather up to this has been favorable and pleasant.

Have got fall work well advanced and most of our threshing done, only Wheat and Peas which have been left over until later.

Friday Sept 26

Day cool but clear and fine, P. Gratton Mason the Parsonage today had a visit from "Hephzibah" (Kenny) Still the old man only if anything a little more sarcastic he loves the Monarchs more than the other settlers in the Plains -

have had no word from Maggie, and today is close a days over meantime what can be the matter have the letters been lost, or is anything gone wrong in Ohio I must write next mail for I cannot stand this uncertainty, have felt light or heavier than I did on the 1st of the month but my feelings are very variable -
