The X-Rays in Joint Tuberculosis.

I find the periodical examination by X-rays of great value in determining the progress of the healing process in joint tubercle where foci are present in the bone. The reparative changes are accompanied by sclerosis, and this is shown in an X-ray picture. Having decided that splints may be left off, I first advise that freedom be given only at night. Then, if, after a fortnight or month, no untoward symptoms arise, I leave off splints during the daytime and allow massage and gentle movements. Thus, cautiously, a return to normal functions is obtained.—W. S. Fenwick; Brit. Med. Journ.
