butter 22 cts per lb 104. Sugar 50. cotton 37. yeast 10 97
sulphur 1/2 lb. 2. shoe polish 3c 7
- 17 Baked today. Jimmie has a tooth ache
- 18 Jimmie's tooth ache has turned to a gum boil
and I am poulticing it
- 19 Very fine weather. Jimmie is no better.
- 20 Friday, our Fast day. Before the service
arrived - a Mr Bland of Cornwall
Methodist church (a cripple), officiated
a very fine sermon. Jimmie's boil broke
last night. He will go to Florida soon
- 21 I was working from memory. it was Mr
Mathewson, preached on Friday. Mr Bland
today. Angus McGregor's daughter died
last night of scarlet fever. got sick Monday
Murphy got 60 dollars from Litch for Jimmie on
Friday
