- Fri Oct 31st clear and pleasant. not feeling well I sat in the house all day. Bilton was here part of the day Sarah was here cleaning house and baking.
- Sat Nov 1st clear and pleasant looks like Indian Summer wether. I pared apples in the fore noon after pitting apples and covering other pits.

Croton November 1902

- Sun Nov 2nd clear and pleasant fore part of the day cloudy in the evening.
- Mon Nov 3rd clear and warm. Bilton was here a while while this fore noon I was paring apples and choreing about the place.
- Tue Nov 4th cloudy and warm. I peeld a few apples Sarah and Mrs Crovidin was picking a few sweet apples.
- Wed Nov 5th cloudy and warm. Sprinkled rain once or twice. I set out a pare tree and shrub that I orderd from the nursery and gathered a few apples.
- Thu Nov 6th cloudy and cool. heavy rain last night. I was over to G. B. Snarys for better. John Webster was here collecting taces. Fred Snary gave me a call.
- Fri Nov 7th clear and pleasant. I set out some bushes and trees for Sarah in the fore noon after noon set out plum trees for myself. Bilton was here this after noon a while.
