Friday 22nd.
Sunshine with a most severe frost. Shelling and grinding
corn. Went to Turners for a little flour but could not get
it. Cutting fire wood and Underbrushing.

Saturday 23rd.
Morning cold but fine milder in the course of
the day. Went to the mouth; settled with Calder
L 7. 17. 6 due him for store goods and provisions.
Paid L 7. 3. 6 for 8 1/2 yds of Canadian cloth & shillings worth
of thread & 4 pounds of starch at 7 1/2 per lb. 3 boxes of Jan caps
at 5 per box. Paid 2 s. 6 d. to Tailor for cutting out 2 pair
of trousers.

Sunday 24th.
Mild and lowering in the morning but sunshine
for a considerable part of the day. Thawing very fast.

Monday 25th.
Getting up sweeds all day it being mild and pleasant.
Robert broke I den's horn temple. In the evening I
settled up accounts with I den for the past year money
due him in all L 14. 7. 6 1/2. Potatoes L 3. 0. 0. and
bill for fish thometring L 9. 7. 6 1/2 d. I gave two
notes payable to I den on order on demand, one of
for L 9. 7. 6. and the other for L 5. 0. 0. so that our
accounts are squared for the past year. The notes are
dated from 26th.

Tuesday 26th.
White frost but got out mild during the day. Got
all the sweeds that could be seen; ground corn
Phillip's doing odd jobs.

Wednesday 27th.
Extremely mild with slight frost in the evening.
Underbrushing Fred cutting slabs.

Thursday 28th.
Mild and wet but in the afternoon part of the day
extremely cold with snow. Shelling corn, making and
benell grinding corn &c.

Friday 29th.
Fixing stove. Went to Turners for barrels and 12 pounds of flour
L 1. 1. 0. 27 3/4 of Beef at 4 1/2. & 10 at 4 1/2 d. 8 lbs. Mutton 6. 8 d. 6 d
