got some bedding for the Church & five pieces
of plank for the door & window arches paid
thirty cents for the plank
- 9 worked half the day at the Church ^{went to}
an Agriculture meeting in the afternoon ^{at the station}
the Rev^d W^m Cochran preached in the school ^{house}

- 11 went to the funeral of Samuel Capland
Lunes he was buried by the Free Masons
there was over 100 teens the Rev^d W^m Robinson
preached in his fathers house
- 12 I made a bolster & stakes for the waggon
Geordy went to a logging bee of John Robertson
- 13 drew dung to the center field through
is very dry fine drawing
- 14 drew dung to the center field west side
dunged 6 redges
- 15 ^{noon} got the horses shod fine rain this after
noon it is very much needed
- 16 fine rain most of the day oiled the
harness put castor oil on them
