1 doz eggs @ 22; sugar 10; salt 10; soda 5 molasses 12; ginger 5
paid 50 on overalls. I canned up the black currants & mended his
overalls. Mrs Riesinger called wanted to send some letters in the office but he
died 28 the girls picked berries at Hewtons Arthur & Paul cut marsh
grass. at night Arthur went in Chippawa & got Jack shod

Thurs 29. I churned a big churning & wrote a letter to Mrs Kent
Arthur ploughing. Paul cut the weeds next the garden Margaret wrote in
Grimble. I planted a lot of beans Margaret washed

Friday 30. I started the green sunbonnet Mary washed
Arthur & Paul drewed the marsh grass after Arthur got
home with the cow from McCreddie Reel picking berries
she made 24 lb. picked 12 baskets. Mary guarded the cows.
Paul went over the river. started late in the afternoon
at 31 Hexumers thrashing Paul helped in place of
Tom McCreddie. Hattie & her mother went in Chippawa took 1 doz

eggs @ 23 got half lb. tea 15 corn 10 candy 2. milk 4
Mary baked bread & the Reel served some. She swept the front room.

I churned. made a custard pie black currant tarts & sponge cake

Jan 3. Margaret went in Chippawa took 7 1/4 m on crock Reel
got one far that he had to long. Mrs Day has our nice little
white stone crock we had in long 4 3/4 butter. she got 100
of threaded wheat. butter 1 lb. black tea 30 sugar 25

2 breads 12 cheese 15 candy 5 cocoa 10 thread 9 = 102
got 20 lb of Reel money & 20 of mine had stewed meat for supper
I washed quite a lot of white clothes. after the dishes. separate

the churn was washed. Reel & Gordon guarded the cows. I had
to carry water from the creek to put them from boiling
Had 4. I washed the cake over. she is sewing or cutting out

her black waist she went in Riesingers after vinegar
