- 25 Pa went with me to Church M^{rs} Gelling went to Lunenburg to preach for Mr Loring who is very ill. Elder gave us a little address & Sunday Orphan read and gave the Hymns Mary M Luman was to church with us, the first time for her to be in the church since finished
- 26 Washed today it is raining
- 28 My birth day. pretty cold, 42 lb tea 30
- 29 Far I went to Lancaster Bred M Gillis
 1 iron pot - 60. 1 spider 50. 1 copper W. chsk 1.70
 at M Pains 50 lbs oat meal 1.60
 at M Crammans 10 lb tea 43 cts per lb 4.30
 40 yds cotton 84.00 3 yds dress goods 20 4.60
 2 lbs raisins 20 cts 3 yds Threw 12 cts 32
 1 yd cambric 10 1 pair rubbers at Jueds 60
- 30 very fine sun shine but cold weather is beautiful but cold The roads good no thawing to speak of
- 31 Murdy old 3 doz at D. M Donalds got 1 pair rubbers for himself 1 for Marum 1.20

April 1883

- 1 Sabbath very fine day but cold a number of parcels were put on the road and some people were seen to pick the parcels up I did not go to church I was not well
- 2 Quite a large Temperance meeting this evening a goodly number signed the pledge exclaiming the rest they got up a petition to lay before the Licence Commissioners who set on Wednesday 4 they to try to reduce the number of hotels in Windsor got 100 lb flour at Lindsays 3.25
- 3 Far went to Montreal this morning to try to get a situation sold 1 doz of eggs at Gadhous got none
 I forgot to rite that Angus the Bailiffs house was burnt on Sunday 1st April they saved ^{goods} but little. Got at M Gillis Lancaster 3.25
- 4 Very fine day look like spring no sugar made yet, that I hear of the fields are covered by snow
