 came from Paris to I Hopkins took Breakfast at Tom
 hotel the old horse to snider for 20 Dollars got 15
 Down to get the other 3 sometime Before June him
 and Paris came Down with me got some Onions
 and Papers from Mrs Hopkins hotel the Canoe
 to Paris for 76 I Hamilton and Tommy Jack
 here Raining some went up with John for
 Potatoes Gordon and I got 3 Bags of Potatoes from
 John and he came Down with them 3rd I
 went to Summerstown to seed fruit
 4th Low Sunday went to the Surgeon Island
 cranes Blackbirds swallows Phebes Robins came
 5th Tapt 2 or 3 Trees sent Gordon over to see if George was
 coming to make the sugar I Hamilton here
 6th crossed to see I Grant got 2 Sacks at Vesper
 for me Lewis & Bloncleaus Daughter ^{Pete camp with the} ^{got the 24 pages} ^{and then I got the 24 pages}
 married to Day took Dinner at Plumettors 7th
 Tapt some Trees John came Down with my
 8th John Charlie Roth Moving away from
 John Hamiltons Tapping to Day 8th Made Mollasses
 about 2 Gallons 9th Boiling in the Bush Willian
 Savelllette here to see if I would trust him Day
 came in the afternoon gave him 5 Ton then he
 came home with the York and Hope 10th Gordon
 went to Hamiltons for a Bag of Grain for the
 Hens got it and a Paper from John Seen
 a cutter crossing Summers Road Sugared
 about 2.5 lb. to Day 11 Boiling in the Bush Sugared
 of to Day over 30 lb. But put in in the Molestos hot 12th Sugared
 over what we done yesterday 13th Sugared to Day 14th
 I think theres is a hole open at Frances Island
 in the W 15th Made about 2 Gallons Mollasses
 and 22 lb of Sugar to Day Killed a crow set 4 more
 to the Marsh water Low ice opened at the Surgeon Island
 16th Gathering some and Tapping 17th Drawing Wood Boiling 18th
 Sugared over 30 lb and 13 of Apruce but its soft our
 Birth Day

 Boiling some Syrup Windy Ice moving slowly a Great
 Jam Down at the Floating Light 20th Drawing Wood
 went to the Head of the Island 21st Chopping in the Grove
 some of the Drags sap not running these few Days as it is
 cold 22nd putting out Manure Booke my axe handle
 set some fire in the Back Marsh the Jam is right
 opposite the Door Cold and Windy Drew the Big Canoe
 out of the Grove seen some kind of a craft coming Down
 from the Mouth of Salmon River Down the Back
 channel it looks like a scow as Bhs Bakers Barge
 yesterday it came Down opposite Na Houtas Island on
 the South channel Great Fire in the Marshes 23rd
 St George's Day some snow Windy Rain Boiling
 24th Boiling ^{put out capoe} ^{Mad Sugar} 25th St Marks Day Fine Windy
 25th old Duncan ^{Mr Dougall departed} Boiling 26th Peggy Bosell and
 Rete and Georges Boy Brought 7 Hats 3 Ells
 Tobacco 2 Hal of Molasses 4 lb of Sugar some out of the
 Pot on the fire Made about 64 lbs put it 2 pots
 to sugar Windy Fine 27th Boiling 28th made Sugar
 29th The Jenny crossed a Jug Propeller went
 Down ^{Planted a few tubs of Potatoes} made 34 lb of Sugar 30th Made 3 Gallons of
 Mollasses Found a young Bull Crowned 2 King
 Pinn near the shore 1st of May Keeping and
 feeding the cattle in from the Sugar Bush
 the Stack Back of the Barn some found
 an Elm Canoe at Na Houtas Island coming Down
 sap not running well gathered 4 parts
 Windy in the Morning got round to East Wind
 Blowed hard to night rained some Sunday
 2nd Reading Livingstones Travels in Africa
 Raining to night Windy high South West and Cloudy 3rd Went
 to the head of the Island took up my 2 Snik Traps in the
 Day shot a Duck did not get him trees not running
 back snowed some this Morning some frost
 last night
