

Aug 16th 1873

Wed. 16. Very hot today, cloudy over afternoon and looking like rain. Had a severe headache and being generally broke up Mrs Cowan & Dr. Harding were the doctors. Thanks for their goodness.

Thursth 17. Raining this morning, and continued all the forenoon, remaining cloudy. Feel much better today, at Prayer Meeting tonight.

Fri. 18. Cool and cloudy, it rained a little during the night previous.

Sat. 19. Fine and cool, but cloudy most of the day. Miss Hopper's returned to the school today, stopping at Mrs Cowan's.

Sund. 20. Louly day. John and I spent the day at his mother's & Lawrence. We returned at 5 o'clock for Church here.

Aug 21st 1873.

Mon. 21. Louly day, very hot in the afternoon, spent the evening at Mr Vanhorne's.

Tue. 22. Another Louly day, but hot, Mr Cowan (V.B.) and Mr R. Brash here at Mrs Cowan's, doing a little carpentering job for her. Mr Cowan and I arranged a trip down the River to Lawrence this coming Friday.

Wed. 23. Still another fine day the farmers are very busy now taking in their harvest. Mr Cowan here again today.

Thurs. 24. Another Louly day, not much change in the temperature.

Fri. 25. Fine again today, Billy Clarke did not come back as expected so did not make the trip down the river with Mr Cowan as expected. Spent the evening at Mr Harding's.
