- 17 St Patrick day had a letter, and Star  
receipt from Muddy, Charlotte Dougald

- 19 A fine day 3 1/2 doz eggs got 5 lb sugar, 1 qt syrup  
Penny had a bull calf this morning
- 20 A very fine day a good many in church
- 21 Far came home today, went in the evening to  
the gone with cousin Far, got 4.5<sup>0</sup> butter from Auntie
- 22 10. P.M. snowing and storming Collet moved  
into Lantry house, today. Far came home  
this morning and went back this evening  
I paid Mrs Under the 25 cts. for the Met.  
hodist quilt
- 23 Hut moved one load on to the Curvorn's  
farm, it is cold and wind high
- 24 Cold this morning Penn boys went for straw
- 25 10 1 lb tea at Gentry's 50
- 26 Sold 2 1/2 doz eggs at Hillis. got 1 lb soda. 1 lb  
blue. 2 lbs brown sugar.  
got at F. A's 2 lb green sugar. 15 cts
