in Rieingers had a good visit. Their white-faced
man had a cold on the night - cold wind. Arthur
working on the eleven acre field. Mary up in Peti
Sun 25 Marjorie & Hallie started over the river to see Ida
but could not see her the ice was low. Hallie stayed in the
Burgers all night & Marjorie came over & stayed in
Fennies. I churned for our selves Rieingers had
their sow Arthur & Will went over, they finished their
field when came down here & desked a lot here

Wed 26. We sheared the hens up. He started in soon but
Arthur harrowed & Will sowed & disked & Arthur disked
but it looks like rain east wind for 3 days I ironed
a lot out of the basket. Marjorie & Hallie came home
Paul drove up a night with Donald & cellar plants
& 2 loaves bread & 25 lb sugar

Thur 27. raining this morning I worked at home the
sun came out nice in the afternoon they are working
on the field this afternoon. Marjorie went over to Fennies
to Harry about Ida I mended Paul pants

Fri 28 I churned the first thing so Marjorie could go in
Chippawa to see about what train Will could go in
for Farmer Will & Arthur worked late however
after Marjorie went in Chippawa I washed up a lot of my clothes
everything I had was dirty I washed Paul's clothes & Gordon's shirt
a cold wind had to put on a coat every time I hung out any thing

Sat 29. Hallie took her father & Will to the station. Took eggs
1 dog got a qt. vinegar & can pumpkin 10 lb I made 3 pumpkin pies
a ginger cake & a sponge cake. Arthur finishing up the oat ground
he swept the front room & Margaret dusted. She swept the dining room & ironed
her curtains & some of her things & the children. I ironed what I washed
& tended the kitchen work

Sun 30 We expected the childrens father but he did not come. Hallie
walked to the brick church. Paul came up from Gordon Arthur took
him to the station at night. Rieingers girls here in the evening
Mon 31. Arthur did some furrowing out on the oat field then ploughed
the potato patch & a land for garden turns upon big lumps I
tucked my flower bed by the house & planted some tulips. Marjorie
took her gladiolus up for him to plant. Will came back from Gordon
and

Tue 1. They started on their own ground. Paul came back from Gordon
after he came Marjorie & him went to Drummondville. had 3 lbs butter & 5
lb flour & 10 eggs & 18.34. - 8 oz bacon paper 5 radish seed 3 bread 10
after they got home he made Popsy harrow the patch & got by
themselves & cellar in I cleared up the dining room & swept washed
the chum & churned yesterday. made pancakes for dinner

Wed 2. he put the Potatoes out & I carried 2 pails of water from
the creek for them & the cellar. Marjorie went to Rieingers
after pieplant & I made 2 pies before she got home with some
Paul got in the other house. I made ginger cookies Marjorie
baked a big baking of bread she has an oven

Thur 3. I got 14 eggs from Hallie to set a hen the only one we have

Marjorie put out two onion sets on the big pens. I planted a lot

of flower seed. Hallie came over yesterday & we divided the big

flower bed. Marjorie working on sweet-scented Geranium. I churned for our selves Marjorie working on

larcher, sunbonnet & her jacket Fannie gave her Paul helped
