Record 436 & 437.

I paid Tom today \$50⁰⁰
an account. Arranged
with Mitchell about
thrashing & also arranged
to have Freeman Barber
come & help. Herbert with
manure

Friday sep 2nd fine
we got car ready
in morning and
shipped cattle to
the Toronto exhibition
in afternoon freight
\$16⁰⁰, I took ~~out~~ Charlie
along with me & Herbert
stayed to look after stock eat
~~the~~ we got 400^{lb} Bran
from Goldies, pd for help
unloading \$1⁰⁰ then we got
settled in stable, about eleven P.M.

Saturday 3rd fine
we got things fixed up
and washed cattle in
afternoon, Herbert plowed
bal of fall wheat field
