22 Ran and I went to Lancaster with dolly. got 4 basket
 peaches. freight 34^{cts} per basket. bought at Dan McCrum
 4 yds black cloth 2.50 per yd \$10. 1 doz spools thread 45
 twist 5. Buttons 20. canvas. 25. boots 1.20. farmers eaten
 exceeding I lost the bill of purchases. and will have to
 trust to my memory. All articles came to 17 dollars add 250
 got 6 yds cloth for Ran at Duns 3⁰⁰ 1.50 was his own. Linen 38^{cts}
 The boys went to the fair at Alex - took Jetty to exhibit got
 nothing for her. got 1st prize for colliflower 50. 2nd for beets
 2d for Carrots. 75 each amount 2⁰⁰ one was kept for fee
 the 2d day of fair was wet. and coming home was
 dark and ugly

28 Friday Murdy Jimmie & Far were at a party at Lancaster
 Murdy got a nice silver watch and F & J. got broad
 pins from the Excelsiors. John Calanach got a silver basket
