- 24 Monday went to John Robatson, home Hall for day 25. Downville for day 25
- 25 Fine Downville came at 8 until evening 5 P M. To steak 4 lbs. 40 Pa & I were at the entertain last night. it was good 40
- 26 Thanksgiving Very few in church. The off was for Cornwall S. Hospital Pa & I as Downville not working. Got $\frac{1}{2}$ 1.00
- 27 Dull day. Hard frost. I took in all the flowers. Jimmie came home yesterday. Began to take up roots on hill by barn. Pa took all garden roots on Tuesday. Murdy up the branch yesterday and today. Jimmie took Rachel home, she got a stab in her breast
- 28 Dull & raw. I cut soap off pot. I was boiling 3 days for bush salt. Murdy went to Green Valley
- 29 Fine day. Murdy, John and boy down snow ground white. Jimmie put up the outside case. Murdy curvy. Pa & Jimmie put up about half of the potatoes. Rachel's stub. looks like a bullet hole. took home the teams and put Rachel back.
- 30 Downville is done painting. He is going to Cornwall. Pa settled with him, paying him \$3.50 and \$6.00 over the rent.
- 31 Happy day. Jimmie and Mrs Brown at Purdie's she got the baby christened. Peter Dymason Randolphs. John Robatson & Blue to dinner

- 1 Wednesday. Very fine in early morning. $\frac{1}{2}$ 2 lb sausage. Killed an old rooster yesterday. Alick McDonald & French mongrel came to the game ground house yesterday. Sent $\frac{1}{2}$ 2.50 for Mrs Jimmie ploughing. Mrs Brown called
- 2 Cold today. Oliver Monterey rented Rue house for winter $\frac{1}{2}$ 1.50, and he to repair it. Put at Willis's $\frac{1}{2}$ tea 20, sugar 25, molasses 22 47
currants 10, raisins 10, lamp 10, lamp with 5. Soda 5 40
Downville left our house
- 3 Fine day frost at night
- 4 Fine in morning. $\frac{1}{2}$ 1 kettle lard 45. butter 2 for 16.90. 95
1 pan bread 20. steak 25. I killed an old hen 45
- 5 Rev Yanner preached at 3 P M.
- 6 Began to snow at 7 A. M. Donald McCrumm paid \$15. on the 4th for ground rent. Gave receipt for the 10, and 5. he paid before. Mrs St Thomas paid $\frac{1}{2}$ 2 dollars for Oct rent. Rain in evening. 2 lb butter 27
- 7 Mrs Ridgway paid $\frac{1}{2}$ 2.00 for Oct. Rain. Murdy went to Bonville down the river. Mrs Brown in Mrs Falkner called in afternoon
- 8 Murdy got home 7 P M. $\frac{1}{2}$ 1 pan bread 20. wool $\frac{1}{2}$ 32 lbs death
- 9 Did not put up flag until 2 P M. and I think it is a little over for mast. It is morning and blowing wind from the west. Jimmie drew home the fence from the ministers lane. Alvin Murdy is putting up a wire netting along the lane, to the Manse. Killed two old hens
- 10 Cold but bright. Jimmie ploughing. Heard results of the Alberta Election. Liberal Government for them
- 11 Thawed of snow. $\frac{1}{2}$ 1 coal oil 20. bread 20. $\frac{1}{2}$ 1 beef 42 82
Jimmie cleaned the furnace pipes
- 12 Fine dull day. Rev. Matherson preached at 3 P M. So far Nov. has not been cold but dull and blustering. Snow and drizzle
