Body up the River they stopt all night
30th Fine Windy Lucia's for Potatoes 25 and
5 lb of Butter 10 the Boys came after Burping
Oliver Drawing stones to the cellar from
the Bank Leander crossed to Summers town
1st of October 1901 M.A. Birth Day
gave her 50 cents Fine cool

Windy Gordon to church Randolph and
Adelaide here took a Dish of Jelly here
frost to night 2nd Ice Windy Fine cool
some Grains of Snow Working at the cellar
Wall Fernandez went to Cornwall with
his Gun to get Ficed Eddy Renshaw
here Killed a Mutton Satchel on the 30th
Looking at my Books 3rd Fine at the
Potatoes took up 30 Bushels to Day
thats 240 on the cellar now Sussy to
Summers town got Sea Working
at the cellar Drawing Stones

James Cameron Island 4th of October 1899
Fine Day October 4 in Bottles Working
at the cellar putting the ground with
the scraper to the wall Lucia's for
Ducks took 1 to Day 25 cents Corn 10 cents
to take the other again 50 cents a couple
Went to Fish Tonia and a Lot of Bouts
a going to Day some Drops of Rain
5th Fine Day Finished the East part of the Wall
Drawing Stones Lucia's to 1/2 Bushel of Potatoes 25
Filing my Saw 6th Fine To 1 Tub of Butter
12 Doz of Eggs to Douquets Working at the cellar
Wall Lewis here Tonia and I Fishing Bait
Sussy and Minnie to Summers town some one
Brought Cabbages 7th Finished the cellar wall
Gordon not Well Drew some of the Tomatoes
for the Frame from the camp took in
the rest of the corn stalks Fernandez
and Minnie to Cornwall the Grenada
aground Late into Summers town he
did not get his Gun Brought Home
Shoes and Shells got a Lot of Papers and
Magazines from D. M. M. 8th Fine E. W. M.
Leander to church Mr Barnhart here I treated
me to a Drop of good Stuff got Shells from
Fernandez Rained hard to night a Lot of
young Chickens came home Gordon's Spt
at 1/2 Hammonds to night
