 Willie got Emory + had to bring us up 2  
 bags coal (Hamilton) and one for Mrs Quinie.  
 I went to H. Matthews sale in P.M. by Mr  
 house coming 8 years old for \$41.00 will be  
 Mrs Dr Smellie funeral to-day.
