Looked like rain and did rain some in A.M. also at intervals in P.M. Thunder and lightning, warm. Wm Indale here drilled up rape and Willie sowed some Ford and Ford honey turnips in A.M. with me all hands off in P.M.

Willie and I drew 3 loads rails from wire fence Gordon St and put up fence from S. S. N.W. to corner of bush. Then brought up load wood. Mary down in A.M. got at Armstrongs on of 10 lbs rape seed wheat gums 25 cts 1 lb cheese 13 Essences 20 ovaline 38 at Stab silk 2 yd 5 at Phillips Paris green 1 lb 20 licquorie 15 fly paper 10

Willie down town at night paid J.M. Welch and Doug Mc Lennan in full 3.00 Wm Indale in full 5.00
