Frosty, snowing most of day, blustering at intervals clear at times. We cleaned grain in A.M. and in P.M. I spread the load measure got at Stephens on fall wheat took another load to T.L. then took load wood down home, brought up papers etc.

Thursday

Frosty cold day, sunny in A.M. snowing in P.M. stormy. I cut wood in bush to-day Willie sorted turnips.

Friday

Very frosty day sunny. We cut wood to-day. I went down in cutter for papers and got at Mennis on after 2 case handles 55 pane glass 10x12 5cts left 1/4 in hoop iron 5cts 65cts in all.

Saturday

4

Very frosty day sunny. We hauled back 3 loads manure to T.L. I went down town at night in cutter drove Bella home got from W. Shortland balance on cattle sold Jan 23. 4.00

Sunday

Cloudy frosty got very stormy at night. Mr McVicar preached in A.M. from 2 Cor. 6:2. None of us down at night. Mr Glen fell down in a faint and was taken home from church.

Monday

Considerable snow fell last night - some to-day. frosty. Willie brought up mother in morning. I took wood down in P.M. and 11 bags chaff to Curle's. Received from aunt for butter 58cts. Mr Glen died last night.
