Pm, W. Cloudy, drizzly rain at times
I went to Stevens B.S. Am
4 Put rings in 7 pigs noses & turned them
into old orchard. Cleaned out Pig pen
Am B went to Make Mortar for
Cly Sprague for tanning. Cellar
I went to Stevens B.S. W. a
little drizzly. fine to by rather cool
5 I went to see Bishop. A brought
part of dressed lumber Am
we pulled weeds out of 3 acres full
Went east of dam & scuffled
Mangel drills. They have not come
yet it was too dry. W. fine clear
6. B shined sheep. A tanded Sprague
Am we finished scuffling Mangels
& scuffled early Potatoes below garden
& pulled nearly all weeds out of Wheat
behind barn Pm W. fine clear. Cool
Sunday 7 at home all day. Flax was
here Pm. W. fine clear. Cool
8 I took 5 bags Oats to B. D. & brought
a little lumber from D. Rames that was
dressed & brought home Chop Am
I & P & A drove home some heavy

timbers from D. M. to other place Pm
I went to Cedar Grove Mills for some
Graham flour this Monday. W. warm
9 P & A fixed north fence Am ^{fine clear}
I took old Buggy (that I bought at B.
O's sale) to Whiteville to get Wheels fixed
& I went to Unionville for his road
list Pm. I went to Muley to see Bishop
after supper. W. very warm & dry
10 P & A went to Johnny Rames Am
for a cedar log for stringer for bridge
at our corner on Deborah Townline
Phoned Pm W. very warm a little
11 P & A & Henry went fishing to dead
water of Rouge Caught only 2. W
fine rain this morning good heavy
shower Pm some thunder. Sir John
A Mc Donald was buried this Pm
he died on Saturday evening 6th inst
12 I & Sam went to Funeral of Jacob
Barney (Joseph's son) Baptist man
Preached young David Hoover helped
a little went to Brailaw Peters
Boys made a stone walk along
end of Kitchen Pm B tanded
Mason Am he finished Cellar at once
